Anyone setting up a display must so indicate on the registration form and be authorized by the host club.

Displays will be housed at a location on site as determined by the host club.

Limited, discrete and tasteful signs are allowed.

No electronic display, video, etc., allowed.

The North American Longbow Safari name or logo can be manufactured or sold by only the host club and the Rocky Mountain Longbow Association.

Only the host club is authorized to sell NALS T-shirts and apparel for the duration of the Safari event. T-shirts will be available at the site.

All persons displaying goods must be registered shooters at the Safari.

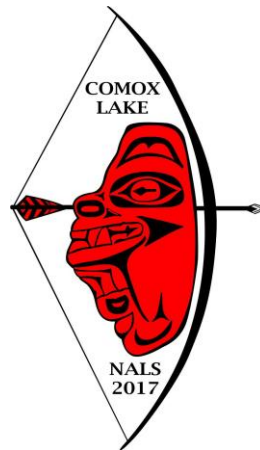

INFORMATION

EQUIPMENT

Bows: Longbows with traditional or reverse handles. String must not touch labs between nocks. Out of respect for those who have paid to attend a longbow gathering we ask that aluminum arrows and bows other than longbows not be brought to the site.

Draw Weight: The NALS is designed for those archers capable of handling hunting weight tackle in rugged hunting conditions.

Arrows: Wood shafting with natural feather fletching. Broadheads will be used for the trail shoot and running animals. Please use two blade broadheads if possible to reduce target damage. Field points are required on flu-flus for bow bird shooting.

CAMPING: Available \$15.00/day fee.

Campground camping with no sewer or electrical hook-ups available. Drinking water will be available at the site. Showers will be available for a fee at the site.

TOILETS: porta-potties will be available.

FIREARMS/FIREWORKS: Not allowed.

FIRE PITS: Campfires in designated area only.

PRACTISE SHOOTING: In designated areas only.

CONCESSION STAND: No BBQ tickets available at the site. Breakfast and lunch will be available Saturday and Sunday. Cold drinks will also be available along the safari course. These services are user pay.

DOOR PRIZES: Anyone wishing to donate door prizes may drop them off at the registration table. They will be gratefully accepted and the donor recognized.
